The deadline for accepting applications for the "Presidential Environment Awards - 2025" extended until May 16

The Central Environmental Authority has extended the deadline for accepting applications for the "Presidential Environment Awards - 2025" program until May 16th, 2025. This decision was made following numerous requests from applicants.

Applications can be forwarded under three main sectors, namely "Industry Sector", "Businesses and Projects Sector" and "Institutions, Mass Media and Social Sector". Accordingly, the "Industry Sector" has two main Sub Sectors as "Large-scale" and "Small and Medium scale". There are 16 separate Categories under each of these Sub Sectors. They are as follows. "Common Waste Treatment & Management Facilities/ Waste Recovery/ Recycling/ Disposal or Processing Plants", "Chemical Industries", "Vehicle Servicing Centers", "Food & Beverages Industries", "Hotels", "Textile Processing Industries", "Pharmaceutical Products and Personal Care Products Industries", "Hospitals", "Rubber Based Products Industries", "Animal Farms", "Apparel Industries", "Tea Processing industries or Tea Factories", "Packaging Industries with Printing", "Mineral related manufacturing industries", "Timber and Wood Related manufacturing Industry", and "Metal nonferrous/ Machinery/ Electronic / Electrical goods and equipment related manufacturing or assembling industries".

"Business and Projects Sector" comprises one Sub Sector and three Categories as follows i.e "Renewable energy generating projects" whereunder there are three Categories as "small scale hydropower projects", "solar power projects" and "wind power projects".

Six Sub Sectors will be evaluated under "Institutional, Mass Media and Social Sector". They are, "Schools", "Environmental friendly public institutions", "Environmental friendly private institutions", "Nongovernmental environmental organizations engaged in environmental conservation", "Environmental friendly inventions (School, University and Tertiary Educational Institute/ Open Category) and "Mass Media" (There are two Categories as "Individual" and "Newspapers, Radio and Television channels")
